Vitae reserves the right to make changes to our Cookies policy. Any such changes shall appear here and become effective immediately. Your continued use of our applications is taken as meaning that you agree to any such changes.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that websites save to your computer. They're here to make the site work better for you, and to help Vitae understand how people use the application.

These cookies aren't used to identify you personally but they can remember activities and preferences chosen by you and your browser. You can manage cookies by controlling which cookies are saved or by deleting them, if you wish.

Types of cookies

A **persistent cookie**, also called a permanent or stored cookie, is a cookie that is stored on a user's hard drive until it expires (persistent cookies are set with expiration dates) or until the user deletes the cookie. Persistent cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as Web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a web application.

A **session cookie**, also called a transient cookie, is a cookie that is erased when the user closes the web browser. The session cookie is stored in temporary memory and is not retained after the browser is closed. Session cookies do not collect information from the user's computer. They typically will store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

Both types of cookie are used on the RDF Planner application.

Cookies for measuring the use of the RDF Planner (analytics)

By understanding how people use the application, Vitae can improve the information provided. This also ensures that the service is available when you want it. Vitae uses Google Analytics to gather this data.

utma	Used to determine unique visitors to our site	Persistent
utmb	Calculates the average length of time users spend on our site	Session
utmc	Works together withutmb to calculate the average length of time users spend on our site	Persistent
utmz	Stores the type of referral used by the visitor to reach our site	Persistent

Cookies to make functions on the RDF Planner application work

These cookies control how the application works by remembering your choices and preferences.

Cookie name	Purpose	Cookie type
ASP.NET_SessionId	Used to identify the user's session. This user session matches up to information stored on the user's visit for their browsing. This will be used to identify the user and store information in the 'dashboard' for logged-in users	Session
.ASPXAUTH	To keep logged in session	Session
